



Health Portal Requirements for the Nursing Program

- American Heart Association BLS Certification
- Pre-Admission Medical History Exam
- Proof of Immunizations
- Proof of Varicella (Chicken Pox) immunization or titer
- Proof of Hepatitis B immunization or titer
- Proof of Measles-Mumps-Rubella immunization or titer
- Proof of Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Td/Tdap/P) vaccination within the last 10 years
- Proof of 2-step negative TB test or negative chest x-ray or QuantiFERON blood test; TB test must be repeated annually.
- Current season Influenza Vaccine-repeated annually.
- Students must have proof of complete vaccination against COVID-19 or an approved NCMC waiver. In general, people are considered fully vaccinated:
 - 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines; or
 - 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine; or
 - Vaccinated per current CDC guidelines; or
 - Request vaccine exception from NCMC
 - *If you do not meet these requirements, you are NOT fully vaccinated regardless of your age.*
- A negative 10-panel drug screen completed no earlier than 30 days before clinical rotation. A link will be sent to students after the semester begins.
10 Panel to include:
(Amphetamines, Barbiturates, Benzodiazepines, Cocaine Metabolites, Marijuana Metabolites, Methadone, Methaqualone, Opiates, Oxycodone, Phencyclidine, and Propoxyphene)

***Please note: A few prescribed medications with review from the lab's Medical Review Officer are acceptable. A positive for Marijuana even with a prescription is not acceptable.
