- 2. Credit will be granted for successful completion as defined as a minimum grade of B/3.0 of articulated courses(s).
- 3. High school transcripts are required to verify courses(s) completed and grade(s) earned.
- 4. The opportunity to apply for postsecondary credit/articulated credit will expire within two years of the student's high school graduation.
- 5. Postsecondary credits/articulated credits will be part of the total number of credits for program completion at North Central Michigan College and will be listed on the student transcripts as credit but with a grade.
- 6. At least 15 credits for Associate Degrees and 8 credits for Certificate of Development Degrees must be completed at North Central Michigan College to earn a credential.
- 7. No tuition or fees will be charged to articulated credits under this agreement. Check specific postsecondary credit agreement/articulated credit agreement for the number of credits possible for each articulated course.
